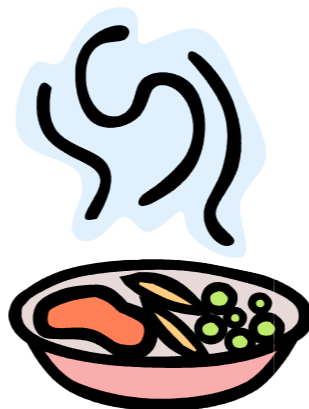
## YEAR 4 VISIT TO WENDOVER WOODS
