Physical Development

This term the children will develop a fluent style of different movements, with developing control and grace in gymnastics. They will learn the basic moves to do different jumps and shapes, and how to do these safely demonstrating strength, balance and coordination. They will also learn how to use a knife to spread butter and jam and other tools to mix things together.

Expressive Arts and Design This term the children will learn about making careful observations in order to create artwork using watercolour paint and pastels. They will learn which prime colours you mix together to make secondary colours.

Literacy

The children will read and use simple recipes and instructions and also use non fiction books to extend their knowledge of foods. They use their phonic knowledge to write recipes beginning to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. The children will consolidate their phonic knowledge to allow them to read longer and compound words.

Understanding the World

In this topic children will experience a wide range of cooking activities including recipes from around the world. Through this, children will learn about different types of foods and cultures . They will be encouraged to observe and talk about the changes that happen to food when it is cooked. The children will learn that some food comes from plants and

animals.

Communication and Language

During this topic children will use new vocabulary to name foods, cooking utensils and equipment. They will describe how different food looks and talk about it's texture and taste. The children will be encourage to ask questions to clarify their understanding.



Mathematics

In Maths, the children will learn to double, halve and share quantities in practical ways and begin to recognise odd and even numbers. They will have more opportunities to recognise, order and talk about numbers up to 20 by using Numicon to make teen numbers and matching these to the numerals.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development The children will learn about the importance of involving others so that they are not left out. Through discussion and practise they will learn about compromising and ways they can solve simple disagreements or problems with their friends by themselves.
