

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will show an understanding of their own feelings and those of others, and begin to regulate their behaviour accordingly. They will be able to explain the reasons for rules, know right from wrong and try to behave accordingly. The children will begin to understand the responsibilities they have to people and the planet now, and increasingly as they get older



Physical Development

The children will learn to negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others. They will demonstrate strength, balance and coordination when playing and will move energetically, such as running, jumping, dancing, hopping, skipping and climbing. They will practise and take part in our school sports day.



Communication and Language

During this topic the children will learn new language associate with the seaside. They will listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions. The children will offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary



Understanding the World


The children will recognise and talk about some of the similarities and differences they notice between Aylesbury and the seaside. They will experience and explore a range of maps before drawing their own maps. The children will also talk about objects that float and sink, referring to the size, shape and mass of the object, and what it is made from, and link this to their first-hand experience.

Mathematics

During this half term the children will continue to practise and consolidate their key mathematical skills, using these to solve a variety of problems.
