Praying with your child:

Prayer is an important way of growing closer to God and deepening our relationship with Him. We can pray at any time of the day or night by speaking to God quietly in our hearts. We can use our own words, or we can use words of familiar prayers. We can also pray silently, feeling God's presence within us and making time to listen to Him.

Take a few quiet moments with your child each day (first thing in the morning and bed time are good times to do this). Encourage them to be still and relaxed, ready to feel close to God. Help them to pray the sign of the cross respectfully and reverently. Encourage them to tell God whatever is in their hearts, reminding them that God always listens to our prayers and that he always answers our prayers even if we do not always understand the answer. A simple pattern of prayer to use is 'thank you, sorry, please', where we thank God, we ask for God's forgiveness and we ask for His help. You can also use any of the prayers above. Always finish prayer time well by reminding your child to pray the Sign of the Cross.
