



# School Uniform Policy

You will be aware that our uniform is something that we are very proud of and it is an important part of our school. By choosing to send your child to our school you are agreeing to our policy on school uniform and you should ensure that your child is wearing the correct St Louis uniform (as per the table below).

**Uniform is as follows:**

	Years 3, 4, 5, 6	Yellow T shirt, Black shorts Trainers
	Years 4, 5 & 6	Black Tracksuit bottoms* and mistral jacket (winter time for Years 4, 5 & 6) <b>*must be appropriate for a PE lesson</b>

Children are allowed to wear summer uniform from Easter until October half term. For girls this means a green and white striped or checked dress. If you prefer, children can wear winter uniform all year round.

If you are at all unsure of our uniform please contact the School Office who will be happy to help.

**Remember:**

- If your child has boots or wellingtons for outside wear they will need to have normal school shoes to change into when they enter the school building. Trainers, boots, are not allowed inside the school building. Other shoes such as 'crocs' and 'flip flops' are not suitable footwear, inside or outside
- Please ensure that all items are clearly marked with your child's name
- Nail varnish is not allowed
- Please note that tattoos, real or temporary, are not and never will be part of our school uniform. Please ensure that your child does not come to school with these
- Jewellery (including those considered to be of Religious significance) and earrings are not allowed but children with pierced ears may wear plain studs, although County safety

regulations state that they must be removed for PE/games and swimming. Pupils who wear earrings other than plain studs will be asked to remove them

- **NO** smart watches are permitted as these are similar to mobile phones.
- Long hair should be tied back with a dark coloured elastic, hair bobble or ribbon. Please no extreme hairstyles or adornments.
